RULES

1. Only abstracts submitted online via the online submission platform can be accepted: [Abstract Submission – Frontier Workshop Bridging Fossil Records and Modern Science - Integrative Approaches to Evolution](#). Submissions by email or other means will not be accepted.
2. Each participant may submit a maximum of **two abstracts**.
3. Abstracts must be written in **English**.
4. Please define all abbreviations and acronyms at first use.
5. The **submission deadline is 30 April 2026, 23:59 CEST**.
6. Abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific committee.
7. Authors will be notified of the outcome by the **end of May 2026**.
8. Selected abstracts will be assigned to either **oral presentations or poster sessions**
 - Oral presentation / Full talk (15 minutes presentation + participation at the Q&A panel at the end of the session)
 - On-site poster (format: A0 portrait/vertical format).
9. Submitting an abstract implies that the presenting author agrees to **register for the event** if the abstract is accepted.

All abstracts will be published in the **HFSP Frontier Workshop “*Bridging Fossil Records and Modern Science - Integrative Approaches to Evolution*” Book of Abstracts**.


ABSTRACT STRUCTURE

1. **Abstracts must have the following structure:**
 - **Title** (mandatory)
 - Maximum 250 characters
 - Use sentence case or standard capitalization (avoid full uppercase unless required)

- **Abstract text** (mandatory)
 - Minimum: **120 words**
 - Maximum: **450 words**
 - Title and author information are not included in the word count
 - **Do not include tables or figures**
- **Keywords** (mandatory)
 - Minimum: 1, maximum: 5

TECHNICAL GUIDELINES

- Never use your browser's back or refresh buttons (you might lose all your data).
- Complete all sections of the abstract submission on the webpage.
- Open each section by clicking the unfold button.
